but my grandson is terrified of her!*

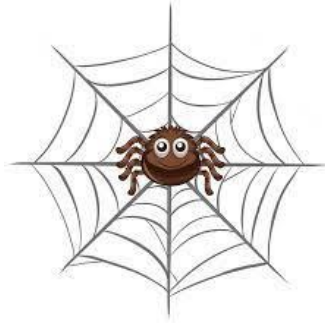
*This is a song to try and convince him that not all witches are horrible or mean -
