

Tommy Thumb

A classic nursery finger play.

Hide hands behind the back and bring them out with thumbs upright.

Wiggle thumbs to the music and bow on the last line. Bring out fingers in sequence for the subsequent verses; fore fingers, middle fingers, ring fingers and little fingers and make them move too.
