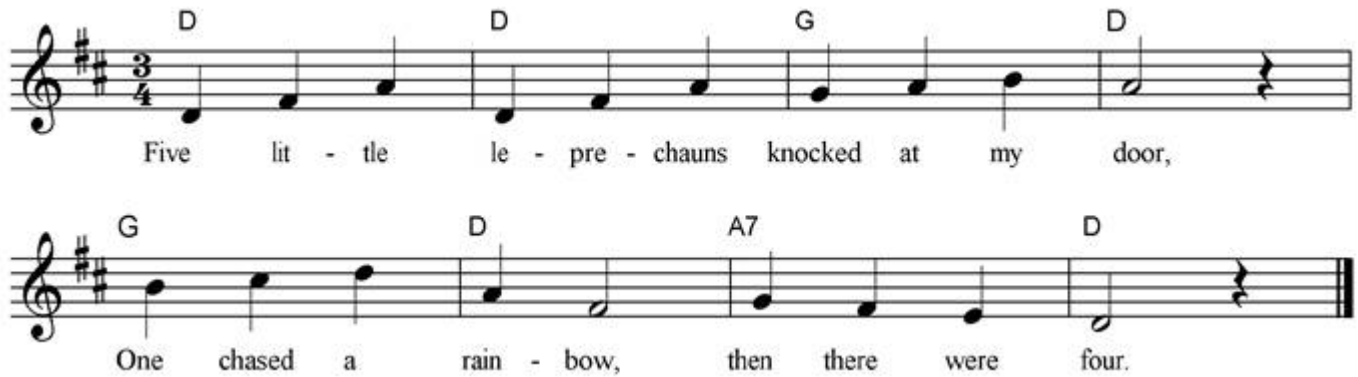


# Five little leprechauns
