

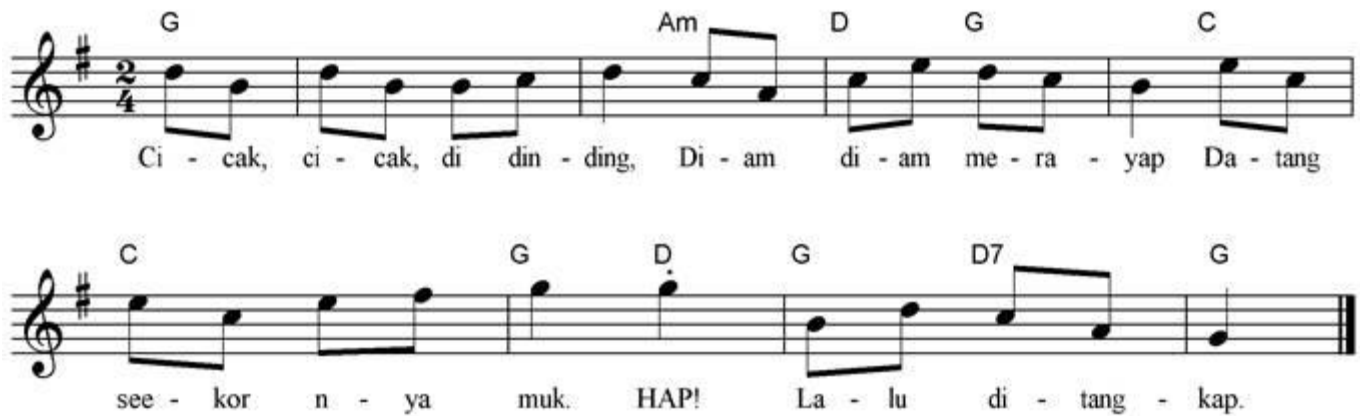
# Cicak, cicak / Lizard on the wall

**1.&2. Creep fingers up child's arm. 3. Tip of thumb and finger buzzes near ear.**

**4. Forefinger tongue uncurls and pops 'mosquito' in palm of hand. 5. Hand 'mouth' opens and closes.**
