


Five pigs so squeaky clean

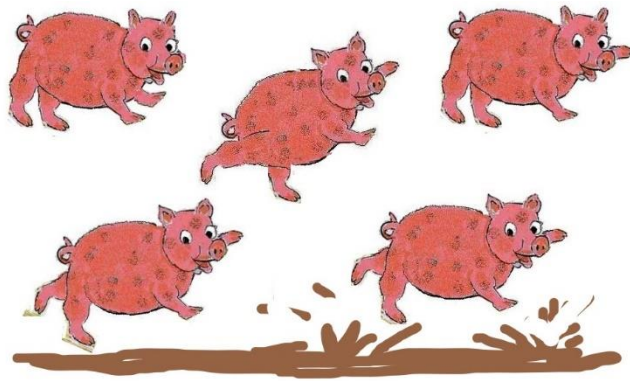
A farmyard number play
