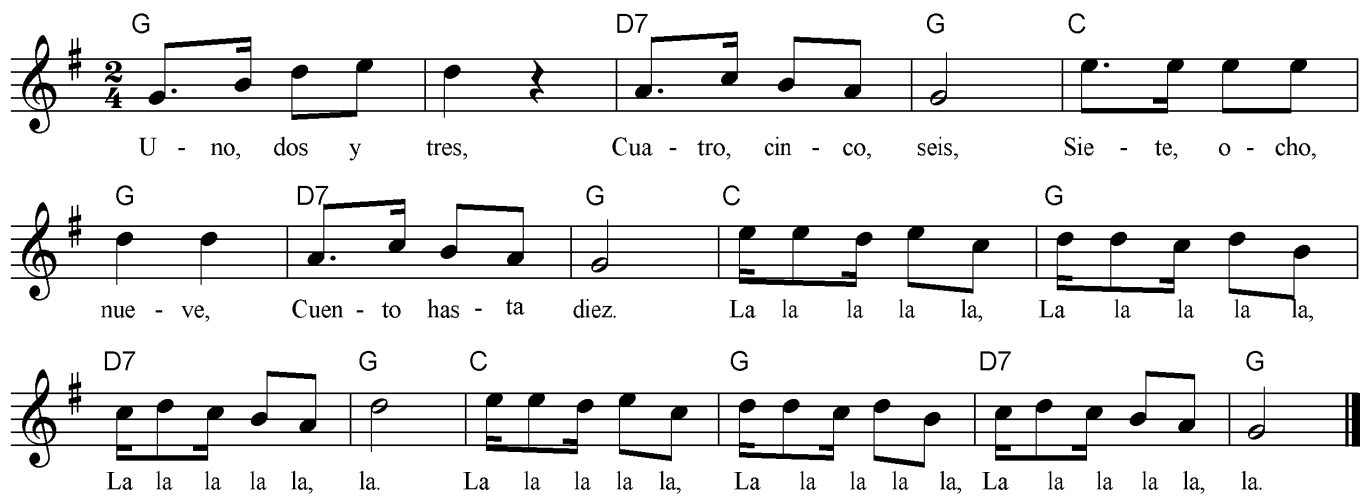


Uno, dos y tres

A bilingual counting song and circle game in both Spanish and English. Learn to count to ten with this simple song based on a Mexican folk tune. Children make two or three circles holding hands. One child stands in the centre of each circle. Those in the circle move around this child who after the second verse points to each in the circle counting to ten. On ten that child turns to face outwards.

Repeat the song until all children have turned about. The circle then moves faster and faster until it breaks and the game ends.
