


Five shiny conkers

An Autumn hand play and number rhyme. Learn the concept of 'one less'. Adapted by Dany Rosevear; for those that are not familiar with 'horse' chestnuts just leave out the 'horse'!

1. Hold up and wiggle five fingers.
2. Make conkers with thumbs and fore fingers.
3. Move hand like the waves, bend down one digit.
4. Make squirrel with hands
5. Each time the song is sung bend down one finger until there are none left.
