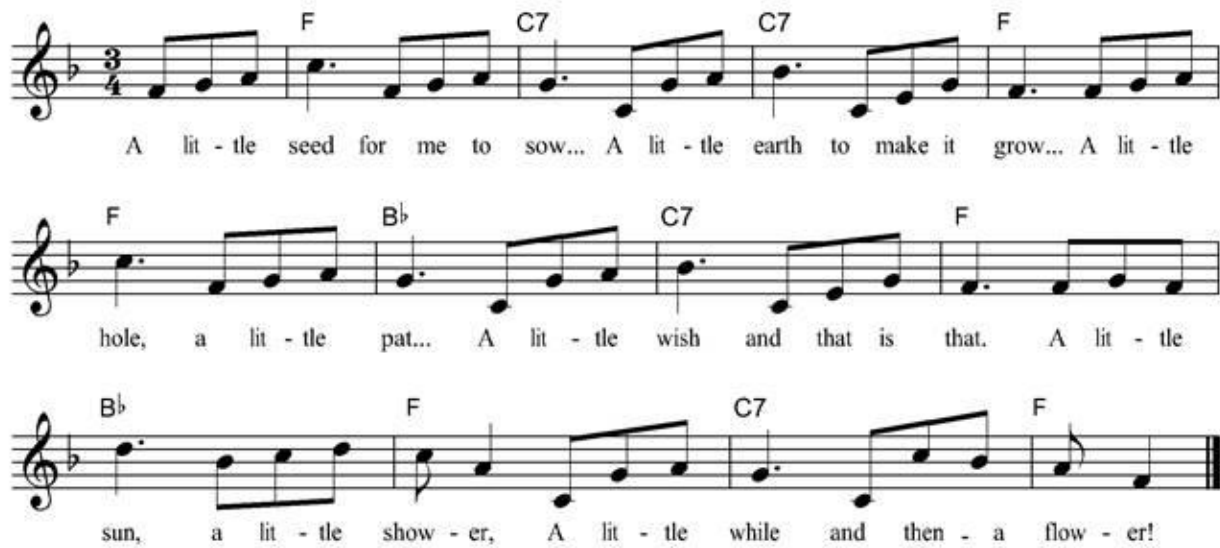


A little seed
