


Where, oh, where, the lion

A pebble passing, call and response game. From 'Feierabend Book of Echo Songs'. Younger children could just slap each hand on the corresponding knee knees to a steady beat: left, right, left, right....

Children sit in a circle with their legs crossed and knees close with a pebble in front of each child.

1. Pick up the pebble with the right hand. 2. Pass the pebble from the right to the left hand. 3. Place stone in front of the next child.

Practice this way of passing the stone rhythmically before singing the song.
