

*Sing as a call and response by repeating the first then the second line.*

*Shakers or other percussion would enhance this delightful music.*

*Children sit in a circle with a rock or plastic + to make a distinctive noise.*

*They sing as they tap the object in front of them twice and then place it in front of the next child to the right.*
