

Weave a web of sunshine



Sit opposite a partner. Line 1. Wiggle fingers to create a circle shape. 2. Wiggle fingers downwards. 3. Move arms up and outwards, draw hands in and cross over heart. 4. With fingers intertwined move hands from side to side. Repeat for 2nd half of verse and twice for the next verse.
