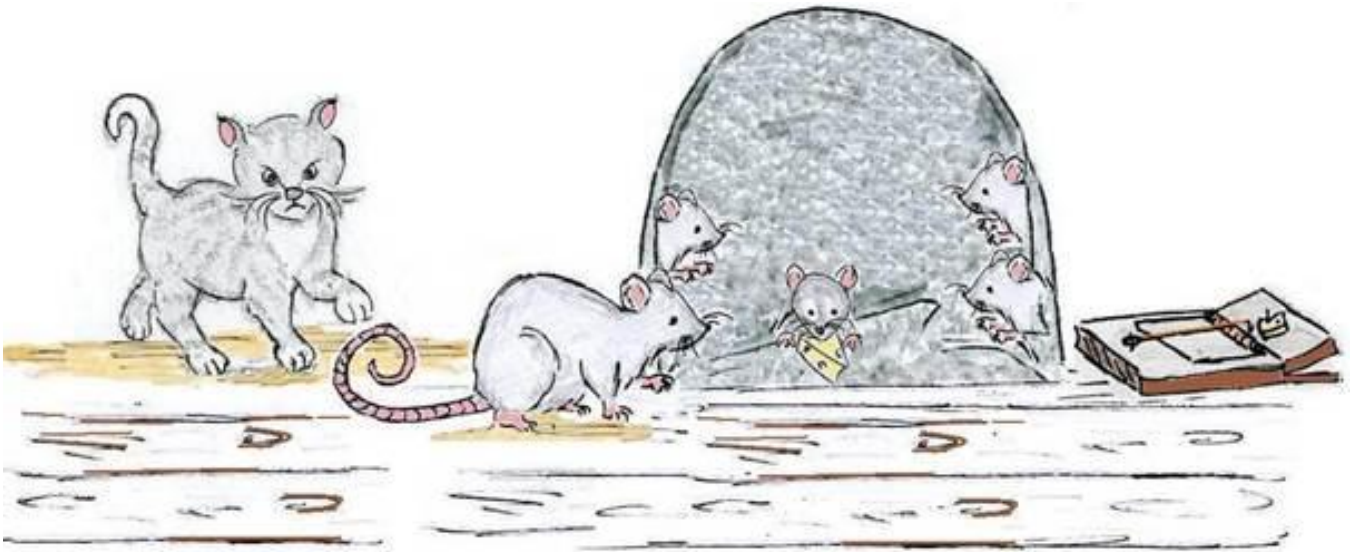


Mousie, mousie
