

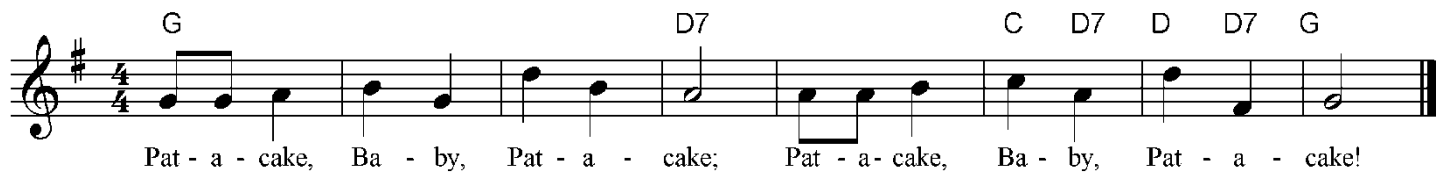
Playing with baby

Sit baby on your lap facing you. Verse 1: Clap hands to the beat. For the last three notes, clap high, low, and in between. 2. Nod head in time to the music. 3. Smile as you sing. With older children repeat the song adding each movement until all three are happening together.
