A simple life cycle hand play. The wonder of transformation from an egg to a butterfly. Set to Incy Wincy Spider and arranged by Dany Rosevear.

1. Wiggle then curl finger and place on palm of hand. 2. Roll forefingers over each other. Pace hands to one cheek. 3. Cross forefingers and flap. 4. Stretch arms. Flap hands linked by thumbs.
