

Five little goslings

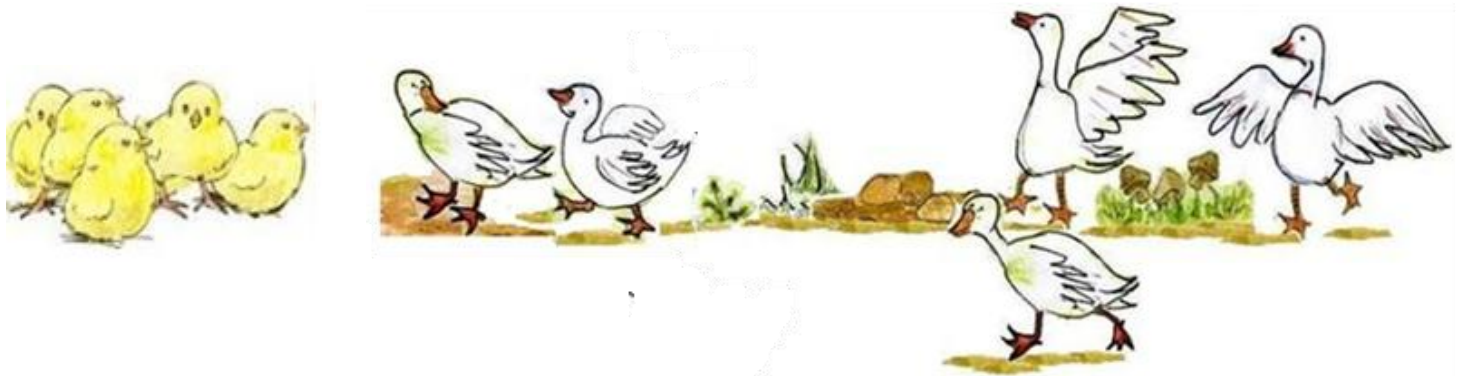

Hold up one finger each time to show 'one more'. Spread fingers wide to show them growing into geese.
