


A hint of Spring

An early Spring hand play. Those early hints that Spring is round the corner raises our spirits as Winter draws to a close.

Verse 1. Thumb and forefinger indicate a small amount. Shape same two digits as a bud. Point to self, shape hands to make a daffodil. 2. Stroke cheek. Dangle fingers. Draw sun and smile on face. Place 'crown' on head.
