


Upstairs to fairyland

This gentle, enchanting bedtime song, written by Stanley Galpin, was featured on BBC radio in 1928. It was usually broadcast at the end of 'Children's Hour', which, during that year, aired regularly from 5:15 pm to 6:00 pm across the BBC.
