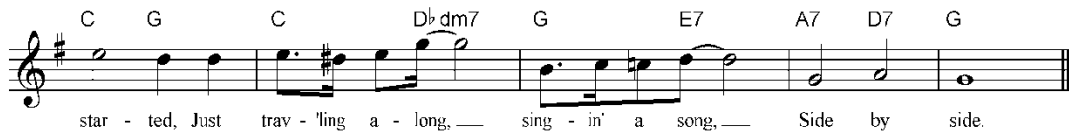
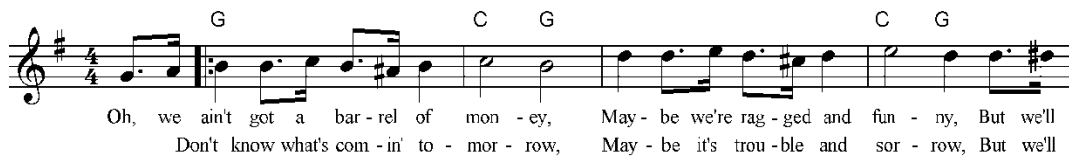


Side by side
