

A crocodile swam in the water

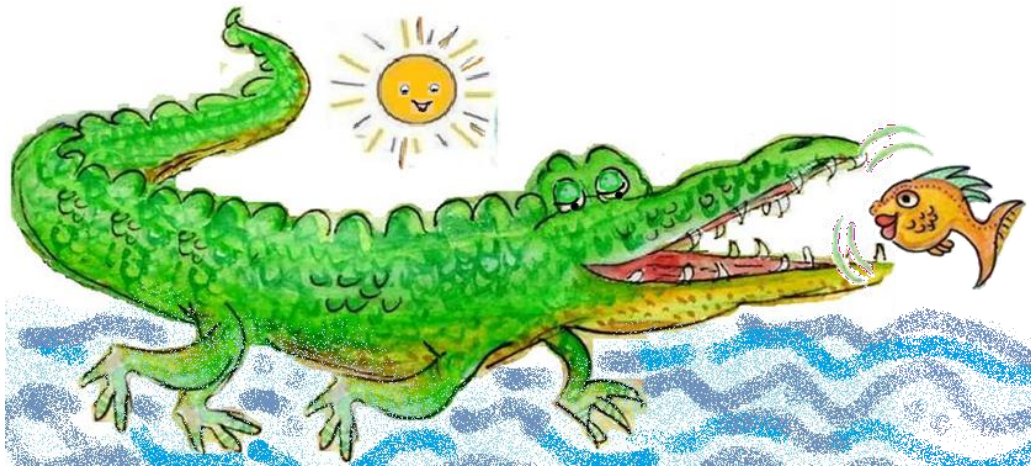

1. Make swimming motions 2. Arms open like a crocodile's mouth. 3. Place one hand on top of the other with thumbs out and turning. 4. Move hands up and down. 5. Arms close. 6. Put hands to cheek. 7. Arms open. 8. Place hands as in 3 and wiggle away.
