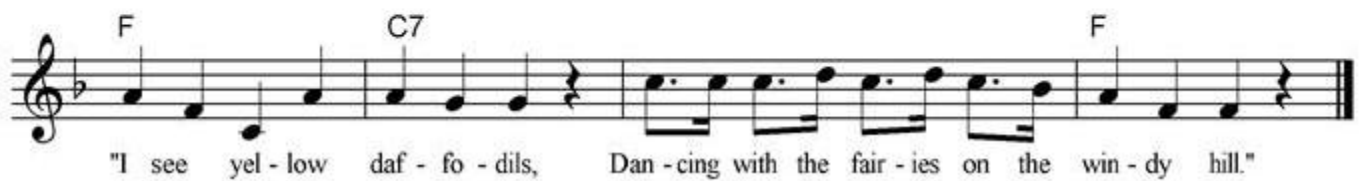
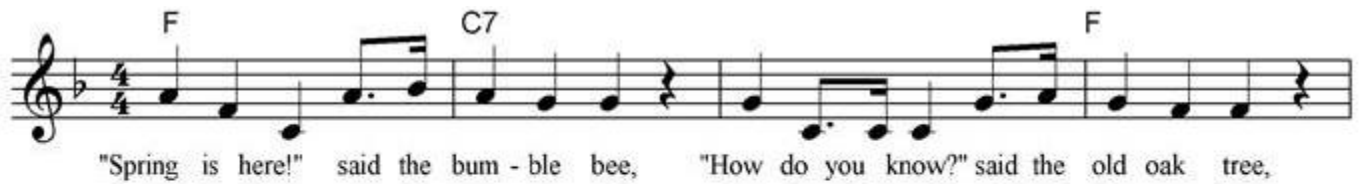


Spring is here
