

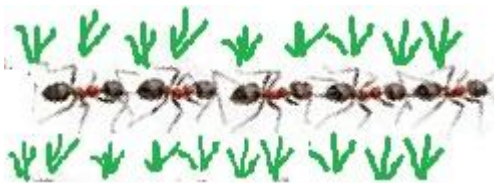
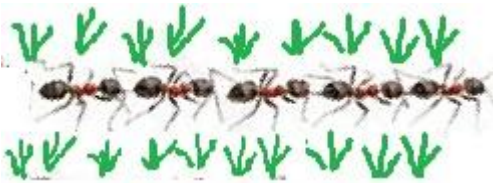
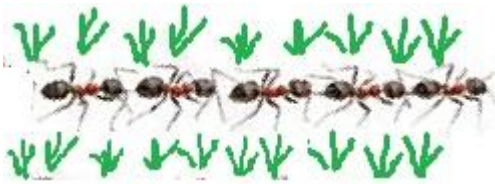
Busy little ants
