

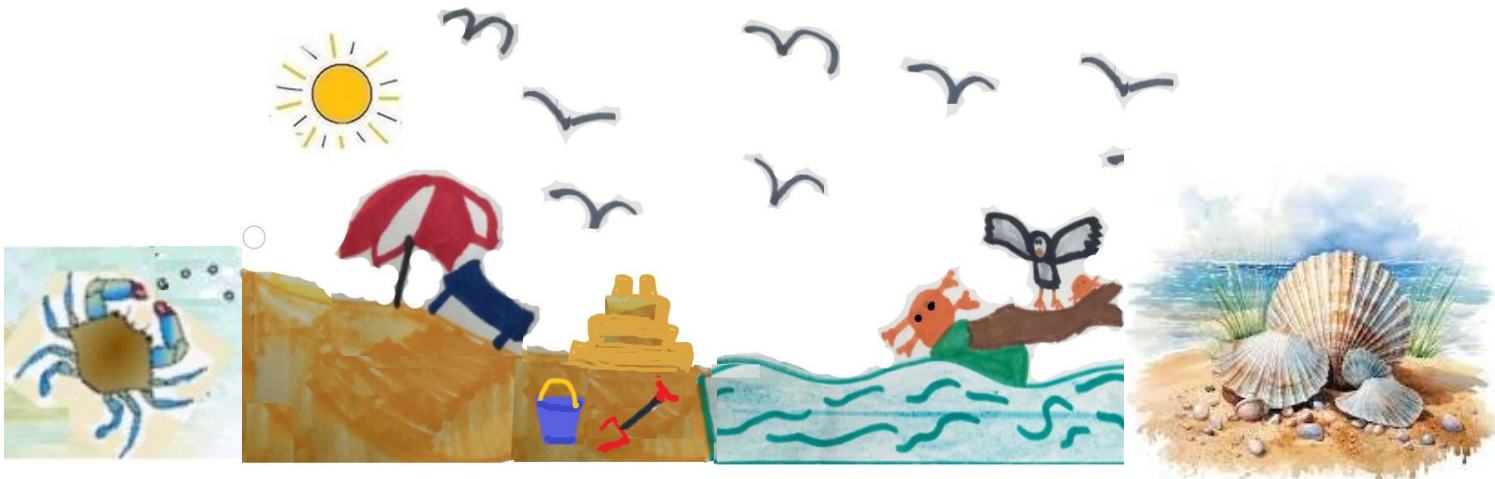
Down at the seashore
