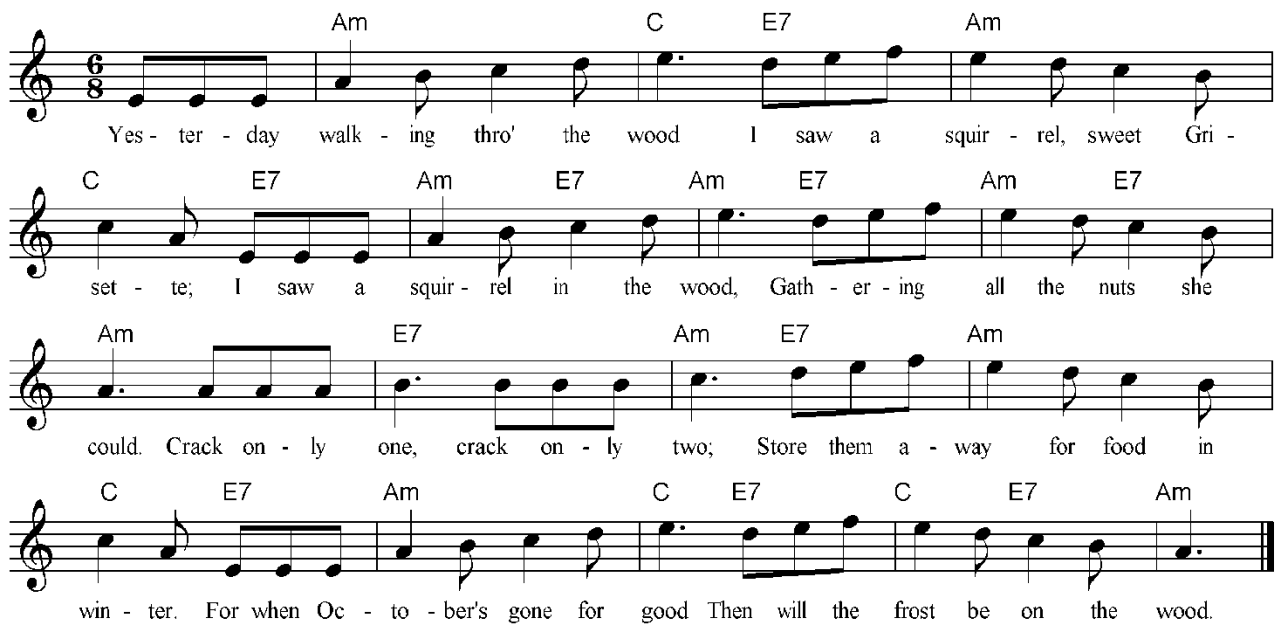


Grisette the squirrel

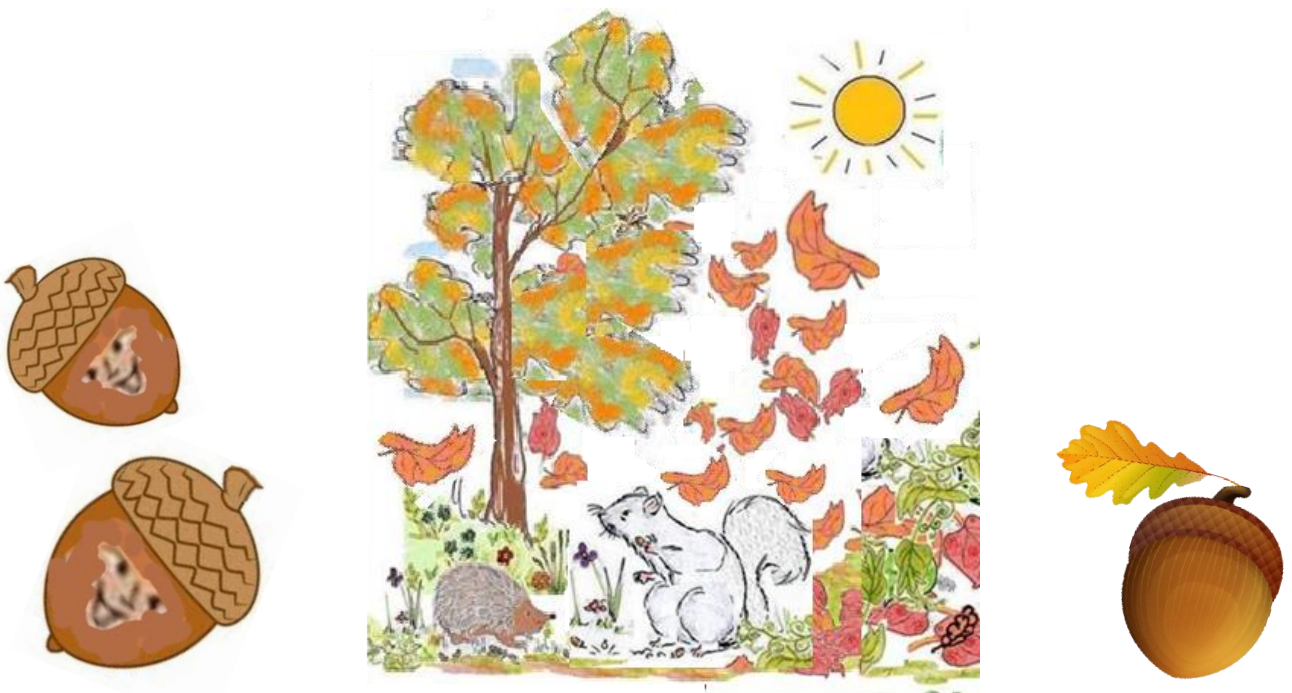
