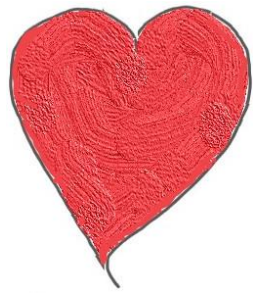


I love the flowers
