

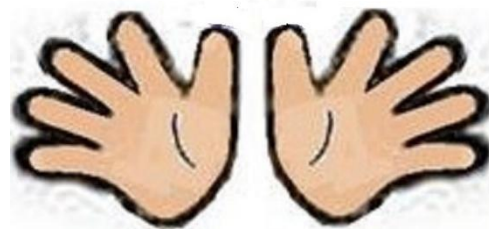
Put your finger on your head
