

See, see, see, three birds are in a tree

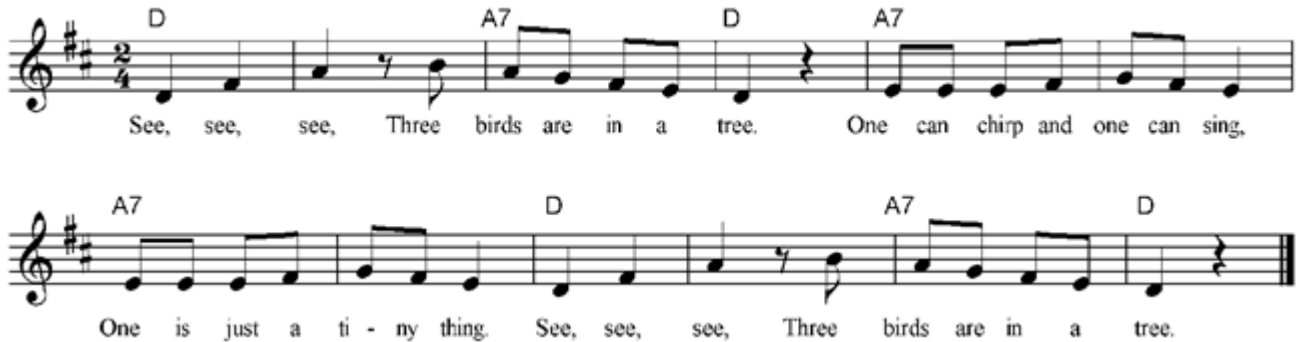
