

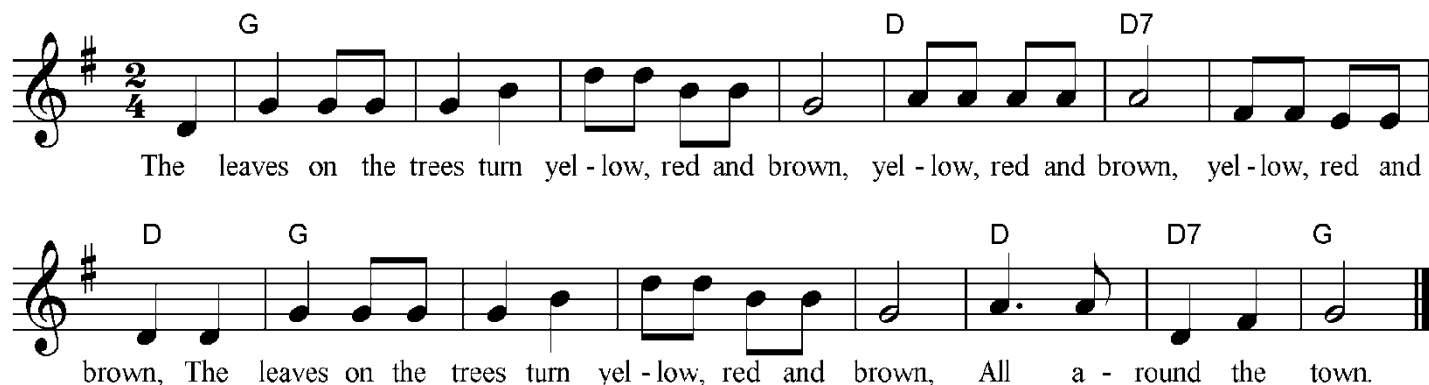
# The leaves on the trees
